<p>Security/Policing for IDPs</p> <p>Security situation of the camps in Bosaso are very peaceful; police forces are working closely with displaced people in the camps, every camp leader have direct contact with nearest police station commander, police handle every case immediately and patrol the camp during night time.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bosaso City has normally five Police stations, those functions properly and handles all crimes cases which happened within the people, two Public police stations are situated in the East of the town, where most IDP settlements located; these two police posts are named <b>MIJIR and Nur Salad</b>. IDPs people are party of the community and use the Public police station's same with other local citizen's equally; having same rights to access social services which is written on <b>Puntland IDPs Policy</b>.</li> </ul>	<p>There's no special police forces deployed and specific police posts for IDPs in the region, last year <b>NRC</b> was built two rooms and latrines in Bariga Bosaso where most of the IDP Camps settled; <b>NRC</b> shelter Staff announced that, these two <b>CGI</b> buildings are allocated for Police to operate closely with IDPs community; unfortunately this plan was failed because of there's no personnel and equipment. There's many local organization helping the IDPs community to solve their domestic crimes locally rather than court, this helps allot of waiting and congestion in the police and court are avoid, also helpful to them legal expenses which higher and they can't afford these crimes may include such Rape, rape attempt and domestic violence these organization's give them legal assistant and frequently visit the IDP centers in the city to explore these cases.</p> <p>During 2015, there was number of IDPs people hired most of the IDP Camps by the government to work with police , every Camp in the city has been registered few people called Community Police,</p>	<p>March 8, 2016</p>
